



Trip to Lydham Hall, 18 Lydham Ave Rockdale 21 November 11 am

We will have an introductory talk and exclusive access to this historic venue, followed by morning tea . One of the oldest homes in the St George area, New South Wales State Heritage-listed, Lydham Hall Historic House and Museum is a sandstone villa built in the late 1870s for businessman Joseph Davis, his wife Ellen and their family. The house was originally part of a 67-acre estate that Davis called 'Lydham Hill', built on the highest ridge in the area and with commanding views of Botany Bay.

The Bayside Council-owned house has undergone extensive repairs and reopened this year after a 4 year closure. The museum is located at 18 Lydham Avenue, Rockdale NSW 2216. On-street parking is available or a short bus trip from Rockdale Station takes you within a 5-minute walk of the museum.
